Smoke Detector Guide

Usually there are one or two types of Smoke Detectors installed throughout your Home. This guide will help you identify the differences so you can properly address alarm or trouble conditions.

Security System Smoke Detectors

Smoke Detectors hooked up to your Security system do not have a battery in the detector, they use the Security System battery for power in the event of a power outage.



There are some Wireless Security Smoke Detectors we have installed, these Smoke Detectors use CR123 or AAA Batteries and will beep when low, but you will also get a trouble and or beeping from the keypad.



Electrical Smoke Detectors (powered by a 110v circuit)

Smoke Detectors hooked up to a 110v Electrical Circuit have a 9v Battery inside them and "Chirp" when the battery is low.
